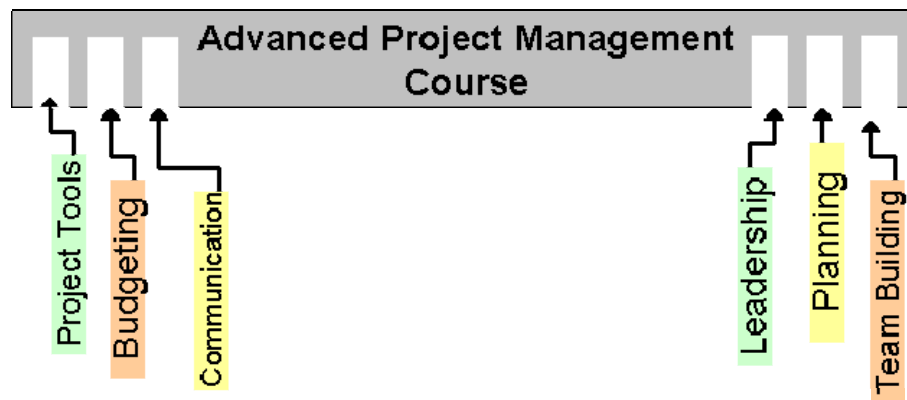


## **Advanced Project Management Bootcamp - Course Overview**
